## a. Discussion of Capital Infrastructure Funding

Mr. Meadows advised the proposal created to fund the radio project has Montgomery County covering approximately 44% of the project costs with the rest being split between the remaining jurisdictions. The proposal still needs to be presented to the Montgomery County Board of Supervisors for approval, but a decision needs to be made in the interim on whether to proceed with the RFP process due to the respective turnaround time of approximately 6 months. Mr. Milburn advised the cost for the consultants to do the RFP is approximately \$110,000 and the writing process can be stopped at any time if necessary.

Mr. Meadows made a motion for the consultants to move forward with the RFP and Mr. Foust seconded. All were in favor.

The Board established a work session for August 15<sup>th</sup> at 3:00pm to further discuss the funding formula.
